### What are the Requirements?

- Must be 19+ years of age
- Good communication skills Honest and dependable
- Criminal Record Check
- Drug/Alcohol testing (may be required)
- Proof of Citizenship (Work/Study Permit, Passport, Status or Birth)
- Valid driver's license (may be required) Physically fit
